Trash is polluting our creeks, rivers, bays and ocean.

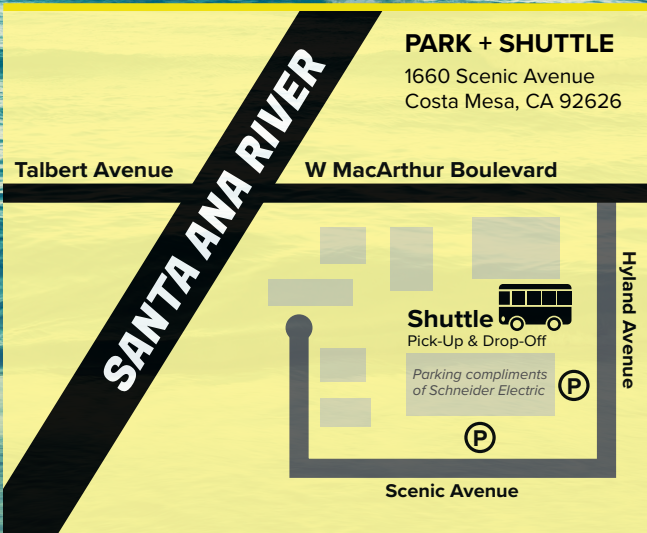
Join your friends and neighbors in helping to keep our waterways healthy.
