TEMPORARY FULL CLOSURE OF BASTANCHURY ROAD LOCATION

OC Loop Trail Segment D Project

Within the Cities of Brea, Placentia and Yorba Linda



WHAT

FULL CLOSURE OF BASTANCHURY ROAD (both directions) WEST OF ROSE DRIVE

- Temporary closure of this section of Bastanchury Road is needed to allow construction activities below and adjacent to the Bastanchury Road bridge for the OC Loop Trail project.
- Temporary no parking along Bastanchury Road between the bridge and Mathewson Avenue (west of bridge).
- Pedestrians, bicyclists and other roadway users will also need to use available alternate routes.
- Construction of OC Loop Trail Segment D is nearing completion. The bikeway will span approximately one mile through portions of Brea, Placentia and Yorba Linda, and connect to the existing El Cajon Trail.

Activities will include the use of large equipment to transform unused dirt area along a flood control channel into a safe, paved bikeway (the bikeway also includes a short portion along the south side of Imperial Highway).

WHEN

Full road closure to be in effect:

**Morning of Monday, July 7 through the
Evening of Thursday, July 31, 2025**

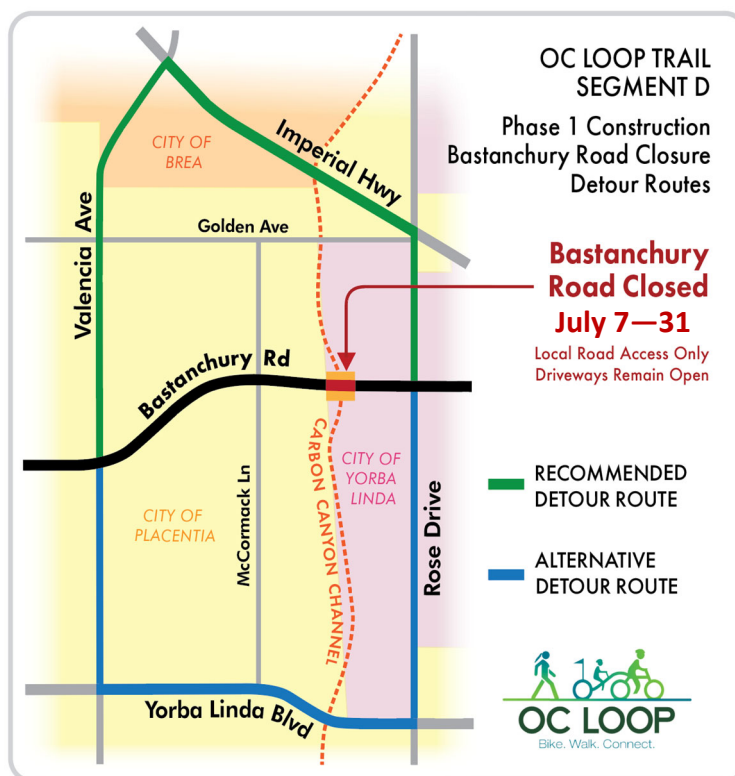
Schedule is subject to change due to weather or other factors.

WHERE

Bastanchury Road bridge spanning between Placentia and Yorba Linda, between McCormack Lane and Rose Drive.
