

**OC FLEET SERVICES** delivers vehicle management services to over 3,000 County-owned vehicles and equipment in County agencies and departments. This includes general maintenance, repair services and managing enforcement of vehicle rules and regulations.

## CORE SERVICES:

- **Maintenance and Repair Services** – Provides repair services to over 3,000 County-owned vehicles and equipment.
  - Manage the County Transportation Internal Services Fun 296 that is used to account for all County fleet costs and establish a Vehicle Replacement Reserve Fund
  - Manage State funds received under Assembly Bill (AB) 2766 Subvention Program (Clean Air Fund 140) for implementation of vehicle emission reduction measures outlined in the South Coast Air Quality Management District mandates.
  - Manage the Compressed Natural Gas Enterprise Fund 270 that supports the operation of the County NCG Fueling
- **Air Quality Regulations** – Manages the emissions compliance programs to ensure that all rules and regulations are adhered to and reported on as required by the South Coast Air Quality Management District.
- **Fuel Program** – Administers the operation of two County fuel stations and one Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) station.
- **Vehicle Operations** – Enforces vehicle rules and regulations to ensure that County vehicles are operated safely and efficiently.

## SERVICE AREA HIGHLIGHT:

OC Fleet Services reduced the number of County vehicle makes and models from 100 to 13 by developing and implementing vehicle specification standards. These vehicles are required to undergo manufacturer recommended preventative maintenance schedules, enforced by Fleet Services, to ensure all County-owned vehicles operate at the highest levels of efficiency.



## FUN FACT

OC Fleet earned the Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Blue Seal Award. The certification is given to maintenance garages that meet stringent criteria which includes technician's skill level, training, safety and tooling.



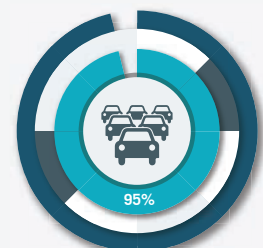
## SERVICE AREA GOAL

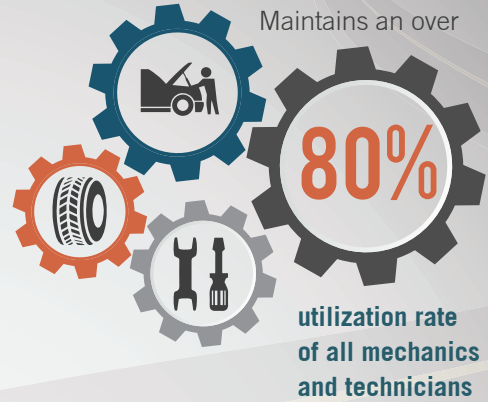
