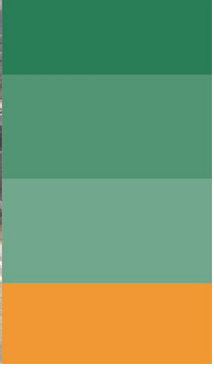


Upcoming Traffic Switch onto North Side of Oso Parkway Bridge as Work Begins on South Side

Oso Parkway Bridge Project



This coming Thursday, August 15, there will be a significant shift in the vehicle lanes used by the public within the project area. Currently, vehicles travel along temporary lanes along the south side of Oso Parkway within the project area. As project construction has reached its half-way point to overall completion, crews will now move construction activities to the south side of Oso Parkway and the vehicle lanes used by the public will be shifted to the north side of Oso Parkway.

This shifting of the temporary lanes – moving the public from the south side of Oso Parkway to new lanes along the north side of Oso Parkway – will start this coming Thursday, August 15 at 5:00 am.

WHAT: Traffic Switch onto North Side of Oso Parkway (north half of new bridge)
WHEN: 5 a.m., Thursday, August 15

- Phase 2 (Aug. 15, 2019 – Project Completion 2020)**
- 1 Shift Oso Parkway vehicles onto north side of overcrossing
 - 2 Construct remainder of Los Patrones Parkway and SR-241 connection
 - 3 Construct remainder of drainage inlets
 - 4 Install overhead sign structures and overhead sign panels
 - 5 Construct temporary signal
- Closed - construction area



OPEN DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- Two lanes in each direction on eastbound and westbound Oso Parkway
- Median left-turn lane to northbound SR-241 on-ramp
- Median left-turn lane to southbound Los Patrones Parkway
- Dedicated right-turn lane from westbound Oso Parkway to northbound SR-241 on-ramp
- Northbound SR-241 on-ramp will have two toll lanes open to traffic
- Southbound SR-241 off-ramp will have only one toll lane open to traffic

CLOSED DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- Far left-turn lane on southbound SR-241 off-ramp
- Far left-turn lane on northbound Los Patrones off-ramp
